**Curriculum**

Our curriculum follows the National Curriculum for England for Key Stage 2. We cover a wide range of subjects, including:

- **Science:** Working scientifically, living things and their habitats, materials, and forces.

- **Art and Design:** Creating, evaluating, and analysing creative work.
- **Music:** Performing, composing, and listening to music.

- **Physical Education (PE):** Developing fundamental movement skills, healthy lifestyles.
- **Computing:** Using technology safely and responsibly, developing digital literacy.
- **Design and Technology:** Designing and making products.
- **Religious Education:** Exploring different religions and beliefs.

### **Class Schedule**

Our daily timetable includes a mix of whole-class teaching, group work, and independent learning activities:

- **English:** Reading, writing, and grammar lessons.
- **Mathematics:** Daily maths lessons and problem-solving activities.
