Welcome to Roe Deer Class! We are excited to embark on this learning journey with you in Year 1 and Year 2. We strive to create a stimulating and engaging classroom environment where children can thrive academically, socially, and emotionally.

### Curriculum

Our curriculum follows the National Curriculum for England for Key Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2). We cover a range of subjects, including:

- **English:** Reading, writing, phonics, grammar, and spoken language.
- **Mathematics:** Number and place value, calculations, measurement, geometry, and statistics.
- **Science:** Working scientifically, living things and their habitats, materials, and forces.
- **History:** Changes within living memory, events beyond living memory.
- **Geography:** Locational knowledge, human and physical geography, geographical skills.
- **Art and Design:** Creating, evaluating, and analysing creative work.
- **Music:** Performing, composing, and listening to music.
- **Physical Education (PE):** Developing fundamental movement skills, healthy lifestyles.
- **Computing:** Using technology safely and responsibly, developing digital literacy.

- **Design and Technology:** Designing and making products.
- **Religious Education:** Exploring different religions and beliefs.

### **Class Schedule**

Our daily schedule includes a mix of whole-class teaching, group work, and independent learning activities.

- **English:** Reading, writing, and phonics activities.
- **Mathematics:** Daily maths lessons and problem-solving activities.
- **Foundation Subjects:** Science, History, Geography, Art, Music, PE, Computing, Design and Technology.
- **Reading:** Guided reading sessions and independent reading time.
- **Playtime:** Outdoor play and indoor free play.
- **Thursdays are Forest School.** Children need to wear their school uniform to school and bring a change of clothes for Forest school in the afternoon – warm clothes that will keep them dry, including boots or wellies.
